BACKGROUND:

The Adams Chapter is comprised of 400+ members who are passionate about protecting trout and salmon in local cold water rivers. The Chapter is primarily concerned with the Boardman, Upper Manistee, AuSable, Platte and Betsie Rivers, although other and smaller cold water streams are of equal interest. 2025 GRANTS:

The Chapter is accepting grant applications up to \$2,500 for restoration or stream habitat activities. The recipients will be announced on or about May 1, 2025. Applications must be post-marked March 31, 2025

Emailed applications will be accepted until 5:00 pm March 31, 2025

Note: 2025 grant funding is not assured until the Chapter knows if adequate funding is available for disbursement.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- The application must be limited to two pages and include:
 - o Executive Summary
- Project Background
- Sponsoring Organization (including contact information)
- Description of activities and expected outcomes.
- Project Budget

GRANT DURATION: ~ 12 Months – Unless otherwise approved in writing.

REPORTING REQUIREMENTS: Minimum one-page written report or oral report at a chapter meeting due upon completion of grant.

ELIGIBILITY NOTE: If you received a grant for the previous year your report must be received prior to March 31, 2025, otherwise you will not be eligible for a 2025 grant.
